AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 131

AN AMENDED ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH A  
REVISED SCHEDULE WHEN OUTDOOR BURNING  
SHALL BE PERMITTED IN THE BOROUGH OF  
FREEPORT AND A MODIFICATION OF FINES  
AND PENALTIES IN CONNECTION WITH A  
VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the  
Borough of Freeport, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by  
authority of the same as follows:

1 (b). Times for Schedule of Permissible Burning

Outdoor burning within the Borough of Freeport shall only  
be permitted on Tuesdays through Fridays from daylight to sun-  
down and Saturdays from daylight to noon. Outdoor burning  
during any other time shall be a violation of the subject  
Ordinance.

2. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance  
or any amendment shall, for each and every violation, upon  
conviction thereof be subject to a penalty as imposed by a  
District Justice of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$50.00  
per day, plus costs of prosecution and in default of payment  
of such fine and costs, imprisonment of not more than three  
(3) days.

Except as in conflict with the above, the subject Ordinance No. 131, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
