

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A DEPARTMENT OF BOROUGH PLANNING
TO BE IN CHARGE OF A BOROUGH PLANNING COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Borough Code, a department of the Borough of Freeport is hereby created to be known as the Department of Borough Planning, which shall be in charge of the Borough Planning Commission. The said Borough Planning Commission shall be constituted as provided by law and shall perform all the duties and may exercise all powers conferred upon Borough Planning Commissions by law.

Section 2. The Borough Planning Commission shall consist of five persons to be appointed by Council. In the first instance one member of said Commission shall be appointed for one year, one member for two years, one member for three years, one member for four years and one member for five years, and annually thereafter a member of said Commission shall be appointed for a term of five years. An appointment to fill a vacancy shall be only for the unexpired portion of the term. All members of said Commission shall reside within the Borough.

Section 3. The said Borough Planning Commission may make and alter rules and regulations for their own organization and procedure consistent with the ordinances of the Borough and the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The members of the said Commission shall serve without compensation and shall annually make a report to the Council of their transactions.

Section 4. The said Borough Planning Commission may hire such employees as are approved by the Council for such salaries and wages as approved by Council and may incur other necessary expenses as approved by the Council. All such expenditures shall be provided for through proper appropriation by Council.
