

ORDINANCE NO. 158

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT A STREET KNOWN AS WASHINGTON STREET AND A DESCRIPTION OF THE SIDELINE OF ITS PROPOSED 30 FOOT ROADWAY FROM THE END OF THE PRESENT PAVEMENT ON EASTERLY LINE OF A 10 FOOT ALLEY TO THE FREEPORT BOROUGH-SOUTH BUFFALO TOWNSHIP LINE AND PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF ANY PORTION OF THE STREET OR ROADWAY NOT WITHIN THE DESCRIPTION WHICH MAY NOW BE USED AS A PART OF WASHINGTON STREET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

Section 1. The following street designated as Washington Street is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Freeport as a 30 foot roadway commencing at the easterly end of the present pavement on Washington Street on the easterly line of a 10 foot alley and extending therefrom to the present Freeport Borough-South Buffalo Township line, the center line of which street is bounded and described as follows and the roadway of said street being 15 feet equidistant on each side from the herein described center line:

Beginning as aforesaid, thence North 82 degrees 50 minutes East 383.40 feet to a point, thence North 83° 45" East 213.75 feet to a point; thence North 84° 00" East 616.28 feet to a point; thence North 66° 29" East 505.85 feet to a point on the Freeport Borough-South Buffalo Township line.

Section 2. Any portion of the said Washington Street now used as a roadway and not within the roadway described in Section 1 hereof is hereby vacated.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
