Ordinance No. 159

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE PAVING OF SIXTH STREET BETWEEN RIVERSIDE DRIVE AND PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD AND FOR THE PAVING OF SEVENTH STREET BETWEEN MARKET STREET AND HIGH STREET

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

Section 1. Assessment is hereby made of the property owners abutting on Sixth Street between Riverside Drive and Pennsylvania Railroad and of the property owners abutting on Seventh Street between Market Street and High Street for the paving of the said portions of Sixth Street and Seventh Street pursuant to the Resolution of the Town Council the 5 day of August 1959.

Section 2. Said assessment shall be in equal assessment according to the foot front rule on each street, shall be made by the Borough Engineer and shall be certified to by the President and Secretary under the Borough seal.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
