

ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE MANNER OF MAKING  
A CONNECTION TO BOROUGH SEWERS, PROVIDING THE ACTUAL  
TAPPING TO BE MADE BY A BOROUGH EMPLOYEE, PRESCRIB-  
ING A FEE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS  
OF THE ORDINANCE

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Freeport and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION I. Any person, firm, corporation, association or other entity desiring to make connection of his property or of any buildings erected on his property with any of the Borough sewers shall comply with the following:

A. Obtain a permit for the tapping of the sewer as heretofore provided and shall pay a permit fee in an amount to be determined by the Town Council by Resolution from time to time.

B. Obtain any other permits which are presently required or which may be required in the future for the completion of the work.

C. Notify the Borough Secretary at least 24 hours in advance when such connection is to be made. All connections will be made only during regular working hours for the Borough employees.

D. The land owner after receiving permit aforesaid shall dig a trench at least 30 inches wide with sufficient shoring to provide a safe working space at the place of the connection and shall provide all material necessary to make the connection.

E. No such land owner receiving a tapping permit shall either personally or by his employee agent or contractor make or attempt to make any connection to the Borough sewer nor shall he make any opening or perforation in the pipe of the Borough sewer. The actual breaking of the Borough sewer and the connecting of the land owner's drain to the Borough sewer shall be made only by a Borough employee under the supervision of the proper Borough official, in accordance with the




Borough specification for its sanitary sewers, making all joints sealed and air tight and to be smoothed and cleaned inside.

SECTION II. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be liable to a summary conviction and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10.00 and no more than \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment thereof, to commitment in the county jail for a period not to exceed 30 days.


