ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 7, ARTICLE IV OF
ORDINANCE NO. 50 ENACTED THE 28th OF DECEMBER 1925
AND APPROVED THE 30th OF DECEMBER 1925 TO PROVIDE
FOR INCREASED CAPACITY OF GASOLINE STORAGE TANKS

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Freeport and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. Section 7 of Article IV of Ordinance No. 50 enacted the 28th day of December 1925 and approved the 30th day of December 1925 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. "No gasoline filling station permitted within buildings, except when vent pipe extends outside. Storage tanks for gasoline shall be buried at such points as shall be permitted by the Chief of the Fire Department or other designated official. The top of each tank shall be not less than three (3) feet below ground level.

Capacity of storage tanks not to exceed a total of 8,000 gallons for any one filling station."


SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in consistent herewith are hereby repealed.
