ORDINANCE NO # 173

FREEPORT BOROUGH

An ordinance of the Borough of Freeport establishing the grade of the center line of Mulberry Way from the east line of Sixth Street to a point at or near the west line of Seventh Street.

Section 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the council of the Borough of Freeport, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same that the grade of the center line of Mulberry Way from the East Line of Sixth Street to a point at or near the West Line of Seventh Street be and the same are hereby established as follows:-

Beginning at the West Line of Sixth Street at an elevation of 789.27 above Borough Datum thence by a rising grade of 1.00% for 150 feet to an elevation of 790.77; thence by a convex vertical curve for 100 feet to an elevation of 791.37 feet; thence by a falling grade of 1.436% for 220 feet to a point at or near the West Line of Seventh Street.

Section 2. That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
