ORDINANCE NO. 174

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 50, APPROVED THE 30th DAY OF DECEMBER 1925, AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 170, APPROVED THE 25th DAY OF APRIL 1961, TO PROVIDE FOR THE STORAGE OF GASOLINE AND UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY THOUSAND GALLONS.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Freeport, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION I. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 50 enacted the 28th day of December 1925 and approved the 30th of December 1925, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. No gasoline filling station permitted within buildings, except when vent pipe extends outside of storage tanks for gasoline shall be buried at such points as shall be permitted by the Chief of the Fire Department or other designated official. The top of each tank shall be not less than three (3) feet below ground level. The total capacity of all storage tanks of one filling station shall not exceed 20,000 gallons.

SECTION II. Ordinance No. 170, enacted the 19th day of April 1961 and approved the 25th of April 1962, is hereby repealed.

SECTION III. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
