

ORDINANCE NO. 179

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING A
BOARD OF HEALTH IN AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF
FREEPORT

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Freeport and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. A Board of Health is hereby established in and for the Borough of Freeport, in accordance with the provisions of Article XXXII of the Borough Code, as added by the Act of 1947 P. L. 1621. The Board of Health shall have general supervision over sanitary conditions in the Borough and shall perform all the duties and may exercise all the powers vested by laws in boards of health in boroughs.

SECTION 2. The first appointments to the Board of Health shall be made by the Borough Council, in the manner provided by law, as soon as practicable after the adoption of this ordinance. It shall be the duty of the Borough Council to maintain the Board of Health at full membership by appointment of new members as necessary to fill vacancies caused by the expiration of terms, death, removal from the Borough or other cause.

SECTION 3. The Board of Health shall meet regularly at a stated time and place, at least once a month, and shall hold such other special meetings as the health conditions of the Borough may require. The said Borough shall hold its annual organization meeting in the month of February, at which time officers for the ensuing year, as prescribed by law, shall be elected.

SECTION 4. If any member of the Board of Health, without sufficient cause, or without having been excused from attendance thereat by the Board of Health, shall fail to attend the stated meetings of the Board of Health, or shall otherwise neglect his duties as a member of the said Board for a period of three (3) months, he shall be considered to have withdrawn from membership on the Board of Health and the Borough Council shall proceed to fill the vacancy thus created.
