ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98, ENACTED THE
3rd DAY OF JUNE, 1946, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 109,
ENACTED THE 2nd DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1948, PROVIDING FOR
THE DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE WITHIN THE BOROUGH
OF FREEPORT

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Borough of
Freeport, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. Section 9 of Ordinance No. 98, enacted the 3rd day of
June 1946 and amended by Ordinance No. 109, enacted the 2nd day of February
1948, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 9. All garbage shall be disposed of without
the limits of the Borough of Freeport. All garbage from
the residences in the Borough shall be collected, removed
and disposed of by the Borough. All restaurants, boarding
houses, hotels, grocery stores, beach houses and commercial
establishments shall have their garbage and refuse collected,
removed and disposed of at the expense of the proprietor
thereof. No garbage from residences shall be collected or
conveyed over the streets, alleys or thoroughfares by the Borough
of Freeport by any person or persons other than the Borough
of Freeport or its duly authorized agents or employees."

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the said Ordinances are hereby
confirmed and are in full force.
