

BOROUGH OF FREEPORT

ORDINANCE NO. 197

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

Section 1. That the grade and center line of Maple Way from the easterly line of 4th Street to the northerly line of Franklin Street Extension in the said Borough of Freeport is as follows:

Beginning at the easterly line of Fourth Street at an elevation of 793.73 feet above Borough Datum; thence by a convex vertical curve for 100 feet to an elevation of 795.90 feet; thence by a falling grade of 2.00 % for 35 feet to an elevation of 795.20 feet; thence by a convex vertical curve for 30 feet to an elevation of 794.25 feet; thence by a falling grade of 5.45% for 55 feet to an elevation of 791.25 feet; thence by a concave vertical curve for 65 feet to an elevation of 790.43 feet; thence by a rising grade of 3.60% for 76.5 feet to an elevation of 793.18 feet; thence by a convex vertical curve for 74 feet to an elevation of 790.83 feet at the northerly line of Franklin Street Extension.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
