ORDINANCE NO. 204

N O T I C E

Pursuant to the Provisions of the Pennsylvania Borough Code enacted the 1st day of February 1966, Article XXXII, The Council of the Borough of Freeport has exercised the powers granted in the aforesaid Article and has enacted Ordinance No. 204, the title of which reads as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO LIMIT AND RESTRICT TO SPECIFIED DISTRICTS OR ZONES AND TO REGULATE THEREIN BUILDING AND STRUCTURES ACCORDING TO THEIR CONSTRUCTION AND ACCORDING TO THE NATURE AND EXTENT OF THEIR USE.
