

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING, ORDERING AND DIRECTING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH NEAR OR ADJACENT MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE FURNISHING AND RECEIVING OF AID AND ASSISTANCE IN THE POLICE PROTECTION.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Freeport has determined that is for the best interest of the Borough to enter into a contract with near and adjacent municipalities for the furnishing and receiving of aid and assistance in police protection.

WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION I. That the police of the Borough of Freeport are hereby authorized to furnish aid and assistance in police protection in and for the municipality of the Township of Harrison.

SECTION II. That the police of the municipality set forth in Section I is hereby authorized to furnish aid and assistance to the police of the Borough of Freeport.

SECTION III. That the proper officers of the Borough are hereby authorized to execute contracts for the mutual furnishing of aid and assistance in police protection as set forth herein with the Township of Harrison and a copy of said contracts being attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibits "A" and "B".
