

BOROUGH OF FREEPORT ORDINANCE NO. 219

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION BY REFERENCE OF THE BOCA BASIC BUILDING CODE FOURTH EDITION 1965 TOGETHER WITH ITS SUPPLEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

Section 1. The BOCA Basic Building Code Fourth Edition 1965 together with its supplements and amendments ^{including the 1968 supplements.} as recommended by the Building Officials Conference of America, Inc., is hereby adopted by the Borough of Freeport by reference under the provisions of the Borough Code, no less than three copies of which are on file in the office of the Borough Secretary, and the provisions of said Building Code are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein to take affect upon and after the effective date of this ordinance. The said provisions shall be controlling within the limits of the Borough of Freeport.

Section 2. All persons found guilty of violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$100 and in default the payment thereof, may be sentenced to the County Jail for a period not to exceed thirty days.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 164 adopting by reference the National Building Code, 1955 Edition Abbreviated, is specifically repealed. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor.
