

ORDINANCE NO. 236

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SUMMARY OFFENSE OF BREACH OF THE PEACE WITHIN
THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Borough of Freeport,
Armstrong County, Pennsylvania; and it is hereby enacted and ordained as
follows:

SECTION I

Any person who shall commit a breach of the peace by engaging in riotous
conduct, fighting, assaulting by affray, inciting or encouraging others to
fight, or engaging in any unlawful act tending to imperil the personal
security of another or endangering the property of citizens or property of
the Borough, shall be guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction, shall
be subject to a fine not to exceed \$300.00 and imprisonment in the County
Jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.
