

ORDINANCE NO. 245

An Ordinance establishing a Borough planning commission in and for the Borough of Freeport and repealing certain prior ordinances.

The Borough of Freeport hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. A Borough Planning Commission, to be composed of five (5) members, appointed as provided by law, is hereby established in and for the Borough of Freeport. The said commission shall perform all the duties and may exercise all the authority vested by law in planning agencies for Boroughs. Provided: The planning and zoning commission now in office in the Borough in the Borough as established by Ordinance 203, shall comprise the planning commission hereby created, but every vacancy in the said commission, regardless of the manner in which they shall occur, shall be filled as provided by applicable law in effect at the time of the happening of such vacancy.

Section 2. The following ordinances are hereby repealed:

1. Ordinance 149, approved January 7, 1959 and entitled: "An Ordinance creating a department of Borough planning to be in charge of a Borough planning commission".
2. Ordinance 203, approved December 1, 1967, and entitled: "An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 149 enacted and approved the 7th day of January, 1959, changing the name of the planning commission to planning and zoning commission.
