

ORDINANCE NO. 247

An Ordinance prohibiting the keeping of pigs within the Borough of Freeport and providing penalties for the violation of the provisions thereof

The Borough of Freeport hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Keeping of Pigs, Maintaining of Pig Pens Unlawful. No person, firm or corporation shall keep any pig or hog at any place within the Borough of Freeport, nor shall any person, firm or corporation maintain any pig pen or hog pen at any place therein, under penalty, upon summary conviction thereof, of a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days. Provided: each day's violation of any provision of this ordinance shall constitute a separate violation.
