

ORDINANCE NO. 254

An Ordinance regulating the manner of distributing handbills and other advertising matter in the Borough of Freeport, prohibiting the scattering or casting thereof upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys and public places in the Borough, and prescribing penalties for violation.

The Borough of Freeport hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Permit Required to Post or Distribute Advertising Matter. No person or persons, without a permit from the Mayor, shall post or distribute any handbills, circulars, samples, printed matter or written matter within the Borough of Freeport. Provided: no permit granted under this section shall authorize the posting or distribution of any matter in a manner prohibited by law.

Section 2. Manner of Distributing Advertising Matter. No person shall distribute any handbills, circulars, samples, printed matter or written matter by casting or scattering the same upon any of the streets, sidewalks or alleys, or other public places in the Borough. Provided: this shall not prevent any person from handing any such matter, upon any of the streets, sidewalks or alleys in the Borough, to any person willing to receive the same.

Section 3. Penalty for Violation. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.
