

ORDINANCE NO. 260

An Ordinance to amend and partially repeal Ordinance 204, approved December 27, 1967, and entitled, "The Zoning Ordinance of the Borough of Freeport of 1967."

The Borough of Freeport hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 204, approved December 27, 1967, and entitled, "The Zoning Ordinance of the Borough of Freeport of 1967", is hereby amended to change the term "Board of Adjustment" to "Zoning Hearing Board" wherever the same may appear in said ordinance.

Section 2. Section 10 of the said ordinance is hereby repealed in its entirety, and a new section, which shall read as follows shall be substituted therefor:

Section 10. The Zoning Hearing Board is hereby established. Such Board is to be constituted as provided by law, and shall perform all duties and may exercise all powers vested by law in Zoning Hearing Boards.

Section 3. Section 11-VII is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11-VII. Violations and Penalties. Any person, partnership or corporation who or which shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than ~~five~~ ^{three} hundred dollars (~~\$500.00~~). In default of payment of

the fine, such person, the members of such partnership, or the officers of such corporation shall be liable to imprisonment for not more than sixty (60) days. Each day that a violation is continued shall constitute a separate offense. All such fines shall be paid over to the Borough of Freeport.
