

AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER XIX PART 2 SECTION 31 PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION OF SEWER RENT OR CHARGE TO BE COLLECTED FROM THE OWNERS OF ALL PROPERTIES SERVED BY ANY OF THE SANITARY SEWERS, SEWER SYSTEMS AND SEWAGE OPERATED BY THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEWER RENTAL OF CHARGE TO BE COMPUTED ACCORDING TO THE WATER METER READINGS OF THE CLEARVIEW WATER COMPANY FOR WATER FURNISHED TO OWNERS SUPPLIES BY SAID COMPANY.

THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sewage Rates

(a) Minimum Charge:

Residential - For each private dwelling or one family apartment unit supplied by Clearview Water Company, a monthly minimum of \$ 3.10

Commercial - For each commercial establishment, office or enterprise supplied by Clearview Water Company, a monthly minimum of \$ 3.10

Industrial - For each industrial establishment or enterprise supplied by Clearview Water Company, a monthly minimum of \$ 3.10

Municipal - A monthly minimum of \$ 3.10

(b) Consumption Charge: Subject to the above charges, for the first 1,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month \$ 3.10 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 3,000 gallons but less than 9,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month \$ 1.14 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 9,000 but less than 48,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month .83¢ per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 48,000 but less than 3,680,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month .50¢ per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 3,680,000 but less than 3,750,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof per month .21¢ per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 3,750,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month .21¢ per 1,000 gallons of water.

(c) Consumption Charge - Multiple Dwelling Units:

Subject to the above charges, in connection with any multiple dwelling unit, any and all consumption charges over and above the monthly minimum will be pro-rated among the number of one-family apartment units in any and all multiple dwelling units located in the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania.
