

ORDINANCE NO. 272

An Ordinance of the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania setting forth maximum weight limits on and for roads, streets, and alleys located in the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania.

THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. The maximum weight limits for the operation of any and all motor vehicles or any combination of which a motor vehicle is a part of upon the roads, streets, or alleys located in the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, are as follows:

WASHINGTON STREET-No Trucks except local delivery

STEWART STREET-No Trucks except local delivery

FRANKLIN STREET-No Trucks except local delivery

HIGH STREET-No Trucks except local delivery  
First to Fifth St.-Except local delivery

MARKET STREET-Fifth to Seventh St.-Maximum weight

DAM ROAD-Maximum weight

RIVERSIDE DRIVE- twenty (20) ton

MILL STREET-Maximum weight

SECOND STREET-Market St. to Riverside Drive-maximum weight

SECOND STREET RAMP-To Buffalo St.-Maximum weight

FIRST STREET-No trucks except local delivery

THIRD STREET-No trucks except local delivery

FOURTH STREET-fifteen (15) ton

SIXTH STREET-No trucks except local delivery

SEVENTH STREET-fifteen (15) ton

LANEVILLE

MAIN STREET-Maximum weight

OLD PIKE ROAD-No trucks except local delivery

OLD MILL ROAD-Maximum weight

BUTLER STREET-No trucks except local delivery

SKILES STREET-No trucks except local delivery

ALLEYS

CHERRY WAY-No trucks except local delivery

WALNUT WAY-No trucks except local delivery

LOCUST WAY-No trucks except local delivery

MULBERRY WAY-No trucks except local delivery

MAPLE WAY-No trucks except local delivery

Section 2. Excluding from the enforcement of this Ordinance , any and all Borough equipment.

Section 3. Any person, firm, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$25.00 or more than \$100.00 per day and in default of payment of such fine and costs of prosecution, shall be subject to imprisonment not exceeding 30 days. Each separate violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or conflicting with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
