

ORDINANCE NO. 280

An Ordinance of the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, designating the intersection of 5th Street (LR 9 & 70) and High Street (LR 69) as a (no turn on red) intersection.

THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1: The intersection of 5th Street (LR 9 & 70) and High Street (LR 9) is hereby designated as a (no turn on red) intersection and no turn on red signs shall be installed in an appropriate place as follows:



| d. High Street (L. R. 69) Westbound | 610.52(b)(2) and (v) |

Section 2: Any person, firm, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than _____ or more than _____ per day and in default of payment of such fine and costs of prosecution, shall be subject to imprisonment not exceeding _____ days. Each separate violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or conflicting with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
