

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER XVI OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PART #3, PARKING

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the efficient administration of the Street Sweeping Program of the Borough of Freeport to establish certain times for sweeping streets of the Borough and to regulate and prohibit parking upon said streets during the designated times for the sweeping thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same.

SECTION I. All improved streets in the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, shall be swept weekly between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 9:00 A. M. on Thursday and Friday or as posted.

SECTION II. The Borough Council of Freeport, within the days and times set forth in this ordinance shall designate the particular time for sweeping of said streets and/or sides of said streets.

SECTION III. The Borough Council of Freeport shall cause the said sweeping times as designated in this ordinance to be posted upon said streets or sides of streets.

SECTION IV. During the times so designated for sweeping parking upon the said street or streets, is hereby prohibited.

SECTION V. All vehicles parking temporarily in a prohibited parking area during posted street sweeping hours shall park no sooner than one hour before the posted time for commencement of sweeping and no later than one hour after the posted time of the termination of said sweeping.

SECTION VI. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two (\$2.00) Dollars, and costs of prosecution, and , in default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.
