

FREEPORT BOROUGH
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 293

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE OF FREEPORT BOROUGH
ARMSTRONG COUNTY, NO. 293, SECTION XIV, SECTION 31,
PART 2 (a.)(b.) – SEWER RENTALS

SECTION 31. SEWAGE RATES:

(a.) Minimum Charge – Amendment to be effective with the January 2010 billing.

Residential – For each private dwelling or one-family apartment unit supplied by The Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township, a monthly minimum of \$ 14.16.

Commercial – For each commercial establishment, office or enterprise supplied by The Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township, a monthly minimum of \$ 14.16.

Industrial – For each industrial establishment or enterprise supplied by The Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township, a monthly minimum of \$ 14.16.

Municipal – A monthly minimum of \$ 14.16.

Capital Reserve Surcharge – A Capital Reserve Surcharge in the amount of Five Dollars (\$5.00 per EDU per monthly billing)

(b.) Consumption Clause – Amendment to be effective with the January 2010 billing.

Subject to the above charges for the first 1,000 gallons of water consumed or any part thereof, per month, \$ 14.16 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 1,000 gallons up to but less than 9,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month \$ 4.57 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 9,000 gallons but less than 48,000 gallons of water consumed or any part thereof, per month \$ 3.32 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 48,000 gallons but less than 3,680,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month \$ 2.05 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 3,680,000 gallons but less than 3,750,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, \$.75 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 3,750,000 gallons of water consumed or any part thereof, per month, \$.75 per 1,000 gallons of water.

This Ordinance Amendment pertains to Sewage Fees only. Any Ordinances prior to this referring to change of sewage fees will be null and void.
