

ORDINANCE NO. 299 1983

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE RAINBOW EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, INC., AND PROVIDING FOR REPRESENTATION ON ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Freeport, acutely aware of their responsibility to act in the best interests of all persons in the Borough of Freeport, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to upgrade the life safety and welfare of all persons in the Borough of Freeport, and

WHEREAS, the Rainbow Emergency Management System, Inc., has been incorporated to serve a public need for protection to life and property in emergency situations by establishing, operating and maintaining an Emergency Management System to function through an emergency telecommunications center and structuring such system to provide service to municipalities as sustaining participants, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Freeport desires to avail itself of the services of the Rainbow Emergency Management System, Inc.

WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Freeport, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by authority of the same.

Section 1. That the Borough of Freeport enter into an agreement, for participation in an emergency management system, with Rainbow Emergency Management System, Inc., upon terms, covenants and conditions to be agreed upon and that said agreement when consummated, be executed on its behalf by its Mayor and its President or Vice-President and its municipal seal to be thereto affixed and attested by its Secretary.

Section 2. The Borough Council of the Borough of Freeport shall appoint a member of Council to the Board of Directors of Rainbow Emergency Management System, Inc., as soon as practicable after the adoption of this Ordinance and whose term shall expire on December 31, 1983. Thereafter whenever a vacancy has occurred or is about to occur by reason of the expiration of the term, the Council shall appoint a member of Council for a term one (1) year from the date of expiration of the prior term to succeed the member whose term has expired or about to expire. The member shall hold office until his successor has been appointed and may succeed himself. If a vacancy shall occur by reasons of death, disqualification, resignation or removal of a member, the Council shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.
