

ORDINANCE FOR FREEPORT BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 300

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG, STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA, TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF CERTAIN DESIGNATED ANIMALS AND TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION AND MAINTAINING OF A SLAUGHTER HOUSE BY THE ORDINANCE AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF FREEPORT.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS

(a) The term person as used in this ordinance shall include all natural persons, associations, firms, partnerships, and corporations.

(b) The term slaughter house as used in this ordinance shall include but not be limited to a building and or location where animals are butchered for market.

SECTION 2

After the effective date of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person to keep any hog, cattle, goat or sheep at any place within the Borough of Freeport, to maintain a slaughter house and or to slaughter any animals for market or resale.

SECTION 3

Any person who shall violate Section 2 of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment in the County jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4

Borough Council of Freeport hereby declares that should any section, subsection, sentence or word of this Ordinance be declared for any reason to be invalid, it is the intent of the Borough

Council of Freeport that it would have passed all other portions of this Ordinance independent of the elimination herefrom of any such portion as may be declared invalid.

SECTION 5

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1984.
