

ORDINANCE NO. 302

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING A ONE WAY STREET AND PROVIDING FOR THE PENALTY OF A VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Freeport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1:

The following is established as a one way street, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on the subject one way street other than in the direction established for traffic on that street:

<u>Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
Mulberry Way	Fifth Street	Fourth Street	westbound

SECTION 2:

Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 and costs.
