

ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO PERMIT DOGS, CATS OR OTHER DOMESTICATED OR NONDOMESTICATED ANIMALS TO RUN AT LARGE; TO PERMIT DOGS, CATS OR OTHER DOMESTICATED OR NONDOMESTICATED ANIMALS TO MAKE CERTAIN NOISES SO AS TO ANNOY ANY PERSON; AND TO PERMIT DOGS, CATS OR DOMESTICATED OR NONDOMESTICATED ANIMALS TO DEFILE AND BEFOUL PROPERTY, ALL IN THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT AND IMPOSING PENALTIES THEREFORE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Freeport Borough Council, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same.

SECTION 1. No dog, cat or other domesticated animal or any nondomesticated animal shall be suffered or permitted to run at large in this borough either upon the public streets or highways or upon property other than the owner of such dog, cat or other animal.

SECTION 2. No person shall allow any dog, cat or other domesticated animal or nondomesticated animal confined on that person's premises to make any loud or harsh noise or disturbance which interfere with or deprive the peace, quiet, rest or sleep of any person within the borough.

SECTION 3. No person shall allow any dog, cat or other domesticated animal or nondomesticated animal owned by him or under his control to defile, befoul, corrupt or otherwise desecrate any sidewalk, walkway or the property of another or to destroy or damage the property of another. In the event that any

sidewalk, walkway or the property of another is defiled, befouled, corrupted or otherwise desecrated as herein provided, the person shall immediately and in a sanitary manner pick-up and dispose of same.

SECTION 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$ 25.00 nor more than \$ 300.00 and all costs of prosecution for each and every offense, and in the default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days in the Armstrong County Jail. Provided: each day's violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. Any ordinance or parts of any ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
