

ORDINANCE NO. 335

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE OF FREEPORT BOROUGH, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, NO. 293, SECTION XIV, SECTION 31, PART 2 (a.)(b.) SEWER RENTALS

SECTION 31. SEWAGE RATES

(a.) Minimum Charge: Amendment to be effective with the January 1999 billing.

Residential - For each private dwelling or one-family aptment unit supplied by The Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township, a monthly minimum of \$ 7.92.

Commercial - For each commercial establishment, office or enterprise supplied by The Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township, a monthly minimum of \$ 7.92.

Industrial - For each industrial establishment or enterprise supplied by The Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township, a monthly minimum of \$ 7.92.

Municipal - A monthly minimum of \$ 7.92.

(b.) Consumption Charge: Amendment to be effective with the January 1999 billing.

Subject to the above charges for the first 1,000 gallons of water consumed or any part thereof, per month \$ 7.92 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 1,000 gallons but less than 9,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month of \$ 2.54 per 1,000 gallons of water.


For all that quantity in excess of 9,000 but less than 48,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month \$ 1.85 per 1,000 gallons of water.


For all that quantity in excess of 48,000 but less than 3,680,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month \$ 1.14 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For all that quantity in excess of 3,680,000 but less than 3,750,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part thereof, per month \$.42 per 1,000 gallons of water.


For all that quantity in excess of 3,750,000 gallons of water consumed or any part thereof, per month \$.42 per 1,000 gallons of water.
