

ORDINANCE NO. 348

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, REMOVING THAT PORTION OF STEWART STREET WEST NORTHWEST OF MILL STREET FROM THE BOROUGH PLAN OF STREETS AND TO CANCEL THE LAYING OUT THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Council recognizes that Stewart Street west northwest of Mill Street has never been opened; and

WHEREAS, Council is mindful that that portion of Stewart Street is too steep to be opened; and

WHEREAS, opening Stewart Street would serve no legitimate purpose to the tax payers of the Borough of Freeport;

WHEREAS, officially removing that section of Stewart Street west northwest of Mill Street from the Borough Plan of Streets and the laying out thereof would be a benefit to Devereaux Motor Sales; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Freeport would benefit by increased tax revenue by said removal;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by Council of the Borough of Freeport, and it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by authority of same as follows:

Stewart Street, lying west northwest from Mill Street, is hereby removed from the Borough of Freeport Plan of Streets and the laying out thereof is hereby canceled as per 53 P.S. 46724, and further, Council recognizes 36 P.S. Section 2131 wherein by authority of said statute Devereaux Motor Sales shall reclaim the unopened part of Stewart Street to the center thereof from both sides.

This Ordinance and the applicable part of Stewart Street, as more fully set forth in this Ordinance, are subject to the Freeport Borough right-of-way in connection with an existing storm sewer line with the Borough specifically reserving the right to repair, maintain and reconstruct said sewer line.
