ORDINANCE NO. 420

AN ORDINANCE OF FREEPORT BOROUGH, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ENACTING STORAGE GUIDELINES FOR WASTE AND CONTAINERS.

**WHEREAS**, it is the duty of the Borough Council of Freeport Borough to ensure the health and welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council desires to prohibit the accumulation of trash in front of properties prior to designated pick up days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Council of Freeport Borough, Armstrong County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the storage of waste and containers shall be as follows:

**SECTION 1.** All containers that store waste or trash shall be in conformity with the requirements of International Property Maintenance Code Section 308.2.1 and 308.3.2 related to Rubbish Storage Facilities and Containers.


**SECTION 2.** All containers must be stored in a manner that ensures containers are not adjacent to the public right-of-way, including the tree lawn area.


**SECTION 3.** Waste/trash containers may only be placed in front of any property beginning at 6:00 p.m. the night before the day of the scheduled pickup day, and all containers must be returned to their storage area on the day of pick-up.
