A RESOLUTION LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2022 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, FOR THE 2022 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Freeport Council of the Borough of Freeport, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 20, 2021, and;

WHEAREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for the Borough operation necessitate property tax rate of 13.00 mills:

WHEARAS, this rate remains unchanged from the previous year.

WHEREAS, the 2022 valuation for assessment for the Borough of Freeport as certified by the Armstrong County Assessor (s) is \$16,620,628


NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED THIS 20TH DAY OF DECEMBER 2021, BY THE FREEPORT COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEPORT, ARMSTRONG COUNTY.

Section 1. That for the purpose of the meeting all general operating expenses of the Borough of Freeport during the 2022 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 13.00 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Borough of Freeport for the year 2022.


