RESOLUTION NO. 2025-02

A RESOLUTION OF FREEPORT BOROUGH, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DCNR) FOR THE PARK REHABILITATION AND DEVELOPMENT GRANT UNDER THE SMALL COMMUNITY PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Freeport Borough recognizes the importance of providing safe, accessible, and modern recreational facilities to enhance the quality of life for its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Freeport Borough is committed to improving Riverside Park to better serve the community by enhancing accessibility and ensuring compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA); and

WHEREAS, the Freeport Borough has identified the need for the construction of an ADA-accessible restroom facility at Riverside Park to accommodate all park visitors, including individuals with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Freeport Borough has approved a budget of up to \$100,000 for the construction of the ADA-accessible restroom facility in Riverside Park and seeks to leverage funding through the Pennsylvania DCNR Park Rehabilitation and Development Grant under the Small Community Program; and

WHEREAS, the Freeport Borough acknowledges that, if awarded, the grant funds will be used exclusively for the completion of the ADA-accessible restroom facility project in accordance with DCNR guidelines and requirements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Freeport Borough Council, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, hereby authorizes the submission of an application for funding to the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources under the Park Rehabilitation and Development Grant Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Council authorizes the Borough Manager and/or other designated officials to execute all documents and agreements necessary for the submission and administration of the grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Freeport Borough is committed to providing the required financial commitment and ensuring the successful completion of the ADA-accessible restroom facility project at Riverside Park.


